## **SECOND CALL FOR PAPERS**

The 2009 Conference of the African Econometric Society (AES) will be hosted by the Centre for Econometrics and Allied Research (CEAR), University of Ibadan and the Nigerian Economic Society. The conference will take place at the Sheraton hotel in Abuja, the capital of Nigeria, from 8-10 July, 2009.

Three excellent keynote speakers are scheduled to address the AES conference participants, including:

**Richard Blundell**, Ricardo Professor of Political Economy, Department of Economics, University College London, and Research Director, ESRC Centre for Microeconomic Analysis of Public Policy, as well as former president of the Econometric Society and the European Economics Association;

**Jan Kiviet**, Professor of Econometrics at the University of Amsterdam, Director Research group UvA-Econometrics and Fellow of the Tinbergen Institute; and

**Yaw Nyarko**, Professor of Economics at New York University, founding Director of Africa House (NYU) and founding Co-Director of the Development Research Institute (NYU).

We invite economists, econometricians, statisticians and other scientists to submit abstracts for presentation at the AES conference.

The abstract should be less than 400 words (approximately one page). Preceding the abstract, clearly state the title of the research paper, JEL classification numbers matching the research, the author(s) and corresponding author contact information (mailing address, phone, fax and email address). In the abstract, briefly describe the theoretical, statistical or econometric nature of the research question, the methodology and expected results and conclusions. Abstracts must be prepared in standard MS Word or Adobe Acrobat PDF format. At least one author of an accepted paper must pay the registration fee and attend the conference. The abstract is due **March 31, 2009**, and can be submitted electronically to [aesprogramme@up.ac.za](mailto:aesprogramme@up.ac.za). Authors will be notified of the status of their paper by **April 11, 2009**. Authors whose abstracts are accepted must submit their full-length papers before **June 12, 2009**.
